



OVR Junior Officials' Development Scoring & Libero Tracking Clinic Outline

JUNIOR SCORER & LIBERO TRACKING PRESENTATION

1. Go to www.VolleyballRefTraining.com
2. Place your cursor over "TRAINING MATERIALS" in the menu
3. Select "Junior Training" from the drop-down menu
4. In the middle of the page (blue section), select "Junior Scorer Clinic" from the list of available clinics
5. The video will play automatically and includes audio, so an audio/speaker system is necessary
6. The video is approximately 41 minutes long
7. For Libero tracking instructions, follow steps 1-4 above and select "NEW! Libero Control" from the list of available clinics
8. The Libero Control video is approximately 15 minutes long
9. For both videos, use the controls at the bottom of the video screen to pause a slide to answer questions, or to rewind to review a specific slide, or fast-forward to advance to a subsequent slide (NOTE: You cannot fast-forward to a slide you have not yet viewed, and a pop-up screen will appear and you must click "ok" to continue viewing the current slide)

IMPORTANT NOTE: In addition to the video presentation above, the OVR Scoring Addendum (PowerPoint presentation, "OVR Libero Serving Modification") must be reviewed as it includes important instructions for recording the Libero serving actions

RECOMMENDED CLINIC MATERIALS

1. Scoring materials should be available for each junior player attending the clinic
2. Materials include:
 - a. Pens/pencils
 - b. Non-deciding set score sheet
 - c. Deciding set score sheet
 - d. Libero Control sheet
 - e. Line-up sheet (optional)

IMPORTANT POINTS FOR OVR JUNIOR SCORERS

1. Records heading information correctly (upper right box)
2. Records officials' information correctly (lower right box)
3. Places three "Xs" – serving team, receiving team, service box
4. Uses pen and pencil in correct sections (if both are available)
5. Monitors and records (✓) servers
6. Records points correctly (slashes and triangles in running score column)
7. Records exit scores correctly
8. Records substitutions correctly (three actions: 1) slash outgoing player & writes sub's number, 2) record score correctly, 3) slashes number in team sub counter)
9. Records time-outs correctly (score of team taking time-out is written first)
10. Circles each team's final score and uses hour glasses for unused points
11. Records set/match results correctly
12. Signs the score sheet
