## OVR Championships 2003

Action was intense at the Ohio Valley Region's 2003 Men's, Women's, Boys', and Girls' Regional Championship tournaments. 882 teams (67%) competed of 1324 teams registered. 788 of those teams were hosted at the Greater Columbus Convention Center, as were the Ohio Valley Region-Molten® 2003 National Bid Qualifiers.
