



# OVR Girls Junior Championships Check-in Procedures

Saturday/Sunday, May 15-16th, 2021

## - - ONE SPECTATOR PER ATHLETE - -

To comply with requirements set forth by the Greater Columbus Convention Center and the City of Columbus Department of Public Health, only coaches, athletes, COVID Coordinators and **ONE spectator PER ATHLETE** will be permitted inside the "tournament bubble" at this GCCC event. When exiting, observe protocols and please exit as quickly as possible. Do not congregate in the concourse. The future of our participation in this facility is directly related to all of us following the rules!

**Upon arrival each day, each team's athletes & spectators will report directly to their court.** COVID Coordinators (CC) must submit a **Team Spectator Check-in Sheet** to OVR tournament staff at the tournament desk. **Neither the head coach nor the assistant coach can coach and be the Covid Coordinator; they are separate roles and require different responsibilities.** Each player and their uniform number will be listed on the Team Spectator Check-in Sheet, and one spectator name may then be listed on the same line with that athlete. At check-in the CC will be given wristbands for the coach(es) and each designated spectator including the CC, which must be immediately distributed courtside. The spectators listed on the Team Spectator Check-in Sheet are to be the **ONLY** guests associated with each individual athlete. The sharing of wristbands violates the Franklin County Health Department's order with contact tracing. **Wrist bands & credentials must always be visible on wrists and are required for re-entry.**

During the first two matches of each day, OVR staff and/or security personnel will visit each court and will verify that all spectators are duly listed and are wearing wristbands. All spectators should be prepared to show a photo ID, if requested.

**Spectators must bring their own chairs, which must be placed only at designated (orange dots) locations marked around each court. Team bench chairs (3) must also remain at their designated/marked locations and may not be moved.**

### ENTRANCE LOCATIONS

- 1 – **Goodale Street** (north entrance, street-level); everyone must enter through the street level doors (not skywalk)
- 2 – **"Arnold" Entrance** (High Street, adjacent to the Arnold Schwarzenegger statue, across from Hilton/Hampton)
- 3 – **Hyatt Concourse Escalators** (south end of building; round-about drop-off point)

**Saturday (Girls 15A):** doors open at 8am; play begins at 9am. Play should conclude before 5pm.

**Sunday (Girls 13A, 14N, 16N):** doors open at 8am; play begins at 9am

**\*\*NOTE:** To reduce congestion in the concourse, please use the entrance for the hall your team is playing in, i.e., B, C, D. Team members do not need to arrive at the same time or at the same entrance.

**All participants are reminded that exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms should result in the athlete, coach, or spectator STAYING HOME, staying IN THE HOTEL, or DEPARTING the tournament.**
