



Team COVID Coordinator 2020-2021 OVR-USAV Season

- Each team must have at least one; more would be acceptable but only one is permitted on the roster per day at an event
 - Consider someone who is a healthcare professional (not required, however)
 - Coordinator must register as an OVR-USAV member – chaperone membership option
 - SafeSport training required
 - Background screening required
 - Coordinator must be listed on the team's tournament entry roster
 - If no Coordinator is designated for a team, a coach will fulfill this role (NOTE: at GCCC events, a COVID Coordinator is required; see below)
- Coordinator is responsible for maintaining a team list AND a spectator list with name/email/phone for contact tracing purposes
- Periodically check the OVR Health & COVID Information page for announcements that may be related to their responsibilities: https://www.ovr.org/health_news.php
- At Greater Columbus Convention Center events:
 - For GCCC events, a Team COVID Coordinator is required on each team roster
 - Will be provided a lanyard/credential to identify them as the COVID Coordinator for that team (basic tournament responsibilities will be listed on back of credential)
 - Coordinate their team's spectator attendance, including spectator list
 - When necessary, assist with ensuring spectators adhere to distancing & face coverings
 - Serve as point of contact for OVR COVID Coordinator (Brian Saterfield)
 - Ensure bench personnel & substitutes social distance where appropriate
 - Ensure bench personnel & substitutes wear face coverings/masks
 - Ensure bench area is entirely clean/clear at end of match – trash, bottles, wrappers, etc.
 - Coordinator may participate in warm-ups (i.e., ball retriever, etc)
 - May be part of work team, if trained (i.e., serve as a line judge, scorer, second referee)
 - May assist with ball retrieval during a match
- For local OVR-sanctioned tournaments:
 - For local OVR-sanctioned tournaments, we highly encourage a Team COVID Coordinator on each team roster
 - Serve as a point of contact with/for the tournament director prior to, and during, the tournament, as needed
 - Serve as a point of contact if tournament director must follow-up with a team in case of contact tracing after the event
 - Fulfill similar duties as listed for GCCC events above
