

Pool play format: 2 pools of 4 teams, 1 pool of 5 teams (3 courts).

For pools of 4 teams, matches will consist of 2 sets to 21 points with a cap at 23 points. For the pool of 5 teams, matches will consist of 1 set to 30 points with a cap at 32 points. Change sides at 7 point intervals. A point will be scored on each rally. If the receiving team wins the rally, they score a point and gain the serve.

Tournament
format:

The top 7 teams advance to the Championship Bracket. The 3rd place teams from Pools B and C and the 4th place team from Pool A will play in a consolation bracket with matches consisting of 1 set to 30 points with a cap at 32 points for 8th place. The 4th place teams from Pools B and C and the 5th place team from Pool A will play in a consolation bracket with matches consisting of 1 set to 30 points with a cap at 32 points for 11th place. In the Championship Bracket, each preliminary match will consist of 1 set to 30 points with no cap. The final match will consist of best 2 sets out of 3. The first 2 sets will consist of 21 point sets with a cap at 23 points. The third set will be 1 set to 15 points with NO CAP. The winning team must win set 3 by 2 points.

Tie-breaking: Since all teams advance to playoffs, ties will not be decided by

playing a set.

1. If 2 teams from the same pool are tied, their head to head match determines their order of finish.
2. If 2 teams from different pools are tied after match and set % and point differential have been calculated, a coin flip will determine their order of seeding.
3. If 3 teams from the same pool are tied after match and set % and point differential have been calculated, a coin flip will determine their order of finish.
4. If 3 or more teams from different pools are tied after match and set % and point differential have been calculated, a coin flip will determine their order of seeding.
