

Publicizing Your Tournament

Your tournament has been sanctioned. So club directors and coaches can now see it. They may send you a note asking to be entered into your event. That is when you use the information in the previous message below on how to add them to your tournament.

You can also send a note to club directors in your area. After you are logged into your OVR account, position your cursor over but do not click on: Juniors". In the drop down men, click on: Clubs and Teams"

Each club is listed and their club director's contact information. At the bottom of the page is again a link: "E-mail individuals listed above"

Location of the site and any special door that they should use or place they should park

Date of the tournament

Age divisions

Price and whom to make the check payable to

When the coaches meeting takes place

What time the tournament starts

Whether parents should bring chairs or seating is provided.

Any other special items.
