

Bob Price, Volleyball Coach at Westerville South High School and Commissioner/ President of the Ohio Valley Region, was inducted to the Ohio High School Volleyball Coaches' Association (OHSVCA) Hall of Fame. No more than three individuals are inducted in any given year, with selection

Jimmy McKinzey Appointed to OVR BoD

At the October board meeting, the OVR directors appointed Jimmy McKinzey (Cincinnati) from a strong field of candidates to fill the seat vacated by Rick Laskey, expiring May 31, 2004.

Jimmy brings considerable experience to the position. He is a National Scorekeeper and a candidate for National Official (NIRSA 2003). He serves as president of the Ohio Valley Volleyball Officials' Assn.,

and earlier this year the Southwest Ohio coaches elected Jimmy as the recipient of one of 5 Golden Whistle Awards. Jimmy also refs collegiate competition, hoping to achieve PAVO National candidacy next fall. Prior to his move from Chicago to Cincinnati over a decade ago, Jimmy was a national officer for NAGVA, directing all four of their national tourneys.
