We are looking forward to a great new season beginning in January. To make the season go more smoothly for everyone, let's not let uniform issues take our focus off the game.

It is required that all teams

have identical shirts/jerseys with contrasting numbers that are 6" tall on the back and 4" tall on the front. Black numbers on red or purple shirts are *not* contrasting. The libero's uniform needs to be of contrasting color, too. Grey and white are *not* contrasting colors. Please see your registration packet for more details on the specifications of the libero's uniform.

Shorts must be the same color. Black and navy blue are *not* the same. Black and dark grey are *not* the same. Navy blue and royal blue are *not* the same. If shorts have trim or a logo, it must be minimal. Black shorts with ½" wide trim are ok, if the rest of the team is wearing plain black. But, black shorts with 3" white side panels are *not* ok. Women are permitted to have a mixture of spandex and boxer-style shorts on the same team, as long as the color is the same.

Teams wearing improper shorts at tournaments will not be allowed to play. According to the rule, games will have to be forfeited until the proper uniform is obtained. We all know that we go to tournaments to play volleyball. Make sure your uniforms conform to the USAV rules so everyone can just *play volleyball*!
