****NOTE:** If only one court (Court 1) has four rounds of play in the bracket – this is typically the Gold bracket – it is possible the other two courts might have only three rounds instead of four. This is 28 matches, not 30. In that case, Referees C and D lose their last match (shaded in gray). This gives Ref C seven and Ref D only six, while Ref B still has eight. Simply replace Ref B on their last match with Ref D (in parenthesis above). This will give everyone 7 matches.
