A couple quick notes about our annual pre-season clinics, which are just around the corner...

#1 - DO NOT register for a clinic if you haven't already done so!

#2 - ALL of our clinics will be "virtual" this year - i.e., online. If you have already registered for one of the in-person clinic, no worries. (see #4 below)

#3 - Your clinic fee (\$10 this) will be paid ONLINE via PayPal. There is also a \$.40 cent transaction fee, so the total charge will be \$10.40. If you don't have a PayPal account, you can set that up now (www.paypal.com), or you can wait until you make the payment to set it up (see #4 below). NOTE: The clinic fee is less this year (vs \$15 last year) because our facility rental expenses will be \$0, but we still must pay clinicians and the online meeting service.

#4 - We will have NEW clinic dates/times published, planned for release sometime next week. If you have already registered for one of the in-person clinics (Toledo, Westerville, Cuyahoga Falls, etc), no worries. Sit tight until I have the new dates/times scheduled, and I'll send a note asking you to re-register. When you re-register, there will be a PAYMENT button for you to click. If you don't already have a PayPal account, you can set it up at that time.

NOTE: PayPal is a secure, world-wide service. If you have concerns making a payment with this option, do a little online research to ease your mind.

#5 - Clinics will be about two hours, max. We will schedule some clinics for weeknights, as well as weekend days and evenings. So, you'll have a variety to choose from and can pick one that fits your schedule. NOTE: There will be a maximum number of attendees per clinic, so give yourself a couple options if your first choice is already filled. The good news is that you won't have to leave your house!

Before sending any clinic questions, please wait until I contact you again with the updated schedule. Most of your questions should be answered in that email.

If you have a significant concern using PayPal, please let me know. If you're already using services like Amazon, Zappos, or any other online stores, I think you'll be comfortable using PayPal.
